Who Is Eligible For Housing Stabilization Services?

- 18 years age or older
- Adults who have a waiver such as CADI, DD, BI, EW or CAC waiver
- Adults who do not have a waiver but have all of the below options:
- Have a documented disability or a disabling condition Medical Assistance
- Experiencing Housing Instability, homeless or at risk of homelessness
- Individual is in a living situation that is provider led and you want to move into a more independent setting.
